Outlets of Little Rock, the only outlet shopping center in Arkansas, features some of the nation's best brand names, including Asics, Banana Republic Factory Store, Brooks Brothers Factory Store, Cole Haan, H&M, J.Crew Factory, Le Creuset, Levi's Outlet Store, LOFT Outlet, Old Navy Outlet, Nike Factory Store, RH Outlet, Tommy Hilfiger, and Under Armour.

With no other outlet center within 164 miles, Outlets of Little Rock fills a significant retail void in the market and is a strong statewide draw. Outlets of Little Rock has excellent highway access and visibility with its location at the intersection of I-30 and I-430 and with 95,000 cars driving by the site daily.

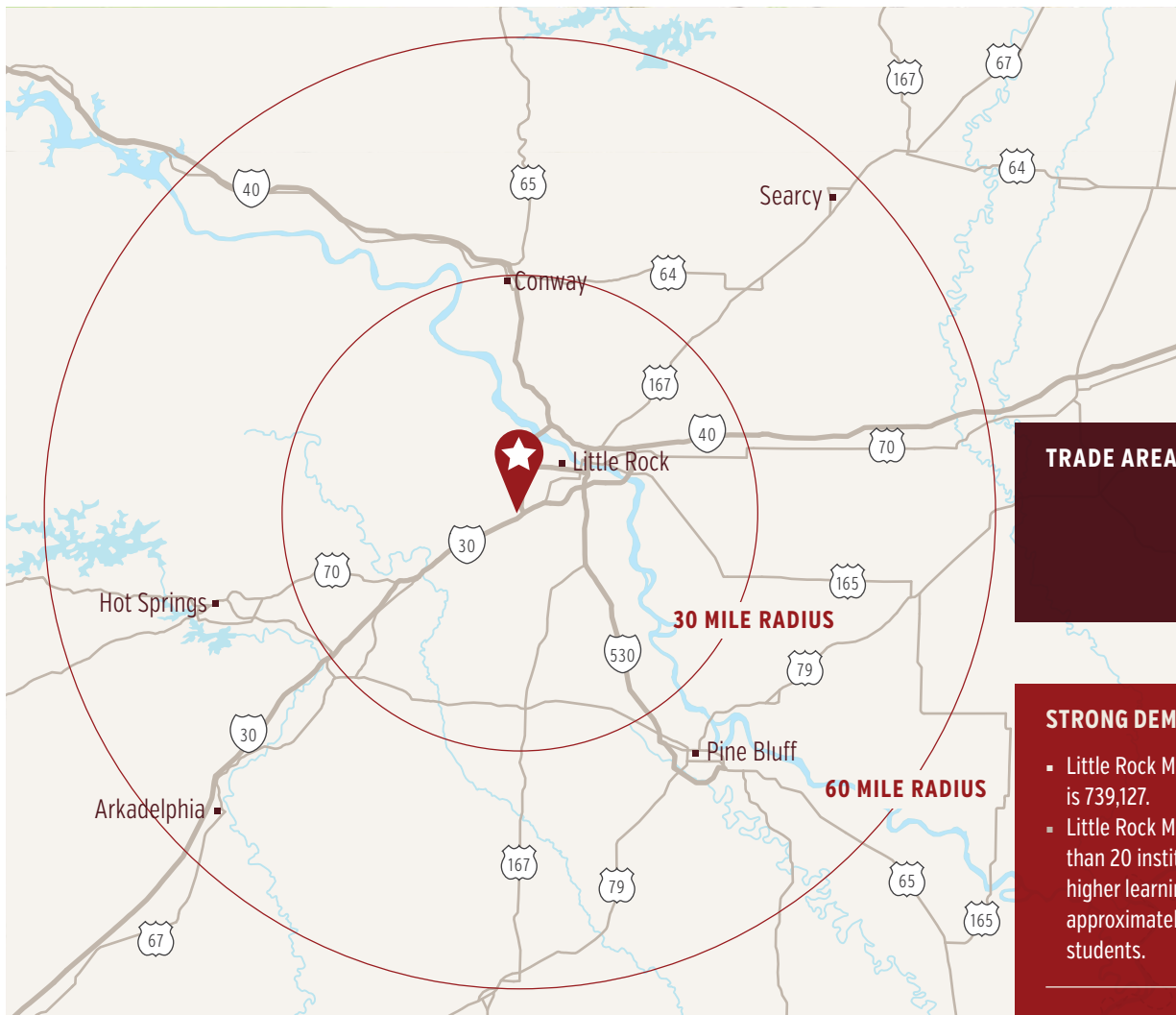


### LOCATION

- Outlets of Little Rock benefits from excellent regional access with its location on I-30, which connects Outlets of Little Rock with downtown Little Rock, the affluent western suburbs of West Little Rock, and retirement communities located in nearby Hot Springs.
- Easily accessible with location at the intersection of I-30 and I-430
- The adjacent Bass Pro Shops, Dave & Buster's, Movie Tavern, Cavender's, and Tru by Hilton draw strong traffic to the site.

# Tourism



Located on the banks of the Arkansas River in the heart of Little Rock's River Market District, the **William J. Clinton Presidential Center** attracts 335,000 visitors annually. It provides 20,000 square feet of exhibit space chronicling American history at the turn of the 21st century and hosts free festivals, musical performances and special events throughout the year.



Outlets of Little Rock is on the major route to the popular resort area, **Hot Springs**, known as "The American Spa" for its natural hot springs. About 40 miles away from Outlets of Little Rock, Hot Springs welcomes over 6.7 million annual visitors.



**The Arkansas River Trail System** winds its way through Little Rock and North Little Rock, connecting 38 parks, six museums and 5,000+ acres of federal, state and local parkland. Thousands of hikers, cyclists, skaters, and joggers flock to the trail to explore its diversity of habitats, landscapes and activities.



In the heart of downtown Little Rock, the **River Market District** hosts a bustling market hall as well as loft apartments, luxury condominiums, remodeled and newly-developed office and retail space, restaurants, bars, entertainment and cultural venues. Popular events such as Jazz in the Park, free Movies in the Park and the Pops on the River draw visitors year-round.



The **Arkansas State Capitol** building, built over a century ago, is one of Little Rock's many tourist attractions.
