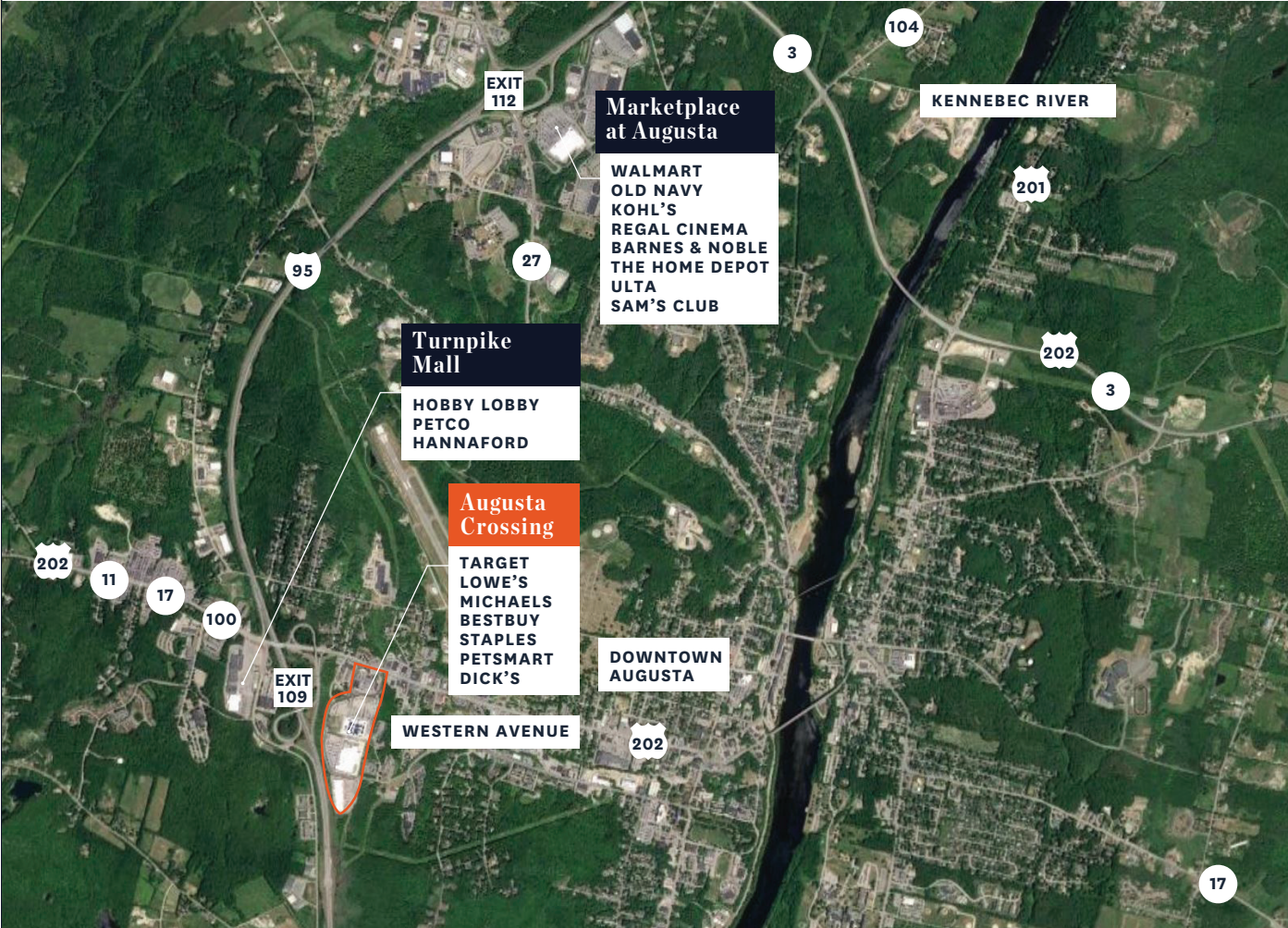

Augusta Crossing, an open-air center in Augusta, Maine, features Target, Best Buy, Lowe's, Michaels, PetSmart, Staples and DICK's Sporting Goods — opening fall 2026.

A prime retail destination located immediately off I-95/Maine Turnpike (Exit 109), Augusta Crossing is connected directly to the central business district as well as to surrounding residential areas. As the capital city and a major hub of business and industry, Augusta has a vibrant economy that serves as a magnet for businesses and residents alike.

LOCATION

- » On Route 202/Western Avenue (Exit 109) off I-95/Maine Turnpike – and just two miles to downtown Augusta
- » Visible and easily accessed from the busy North-South highway corridor of I-95/Maine Turnpike with an ADT rate of more than 34,000 vehicles per day
- » Being the most populated city in Kennebec County, Augusta generates a significant daytime employment rate
